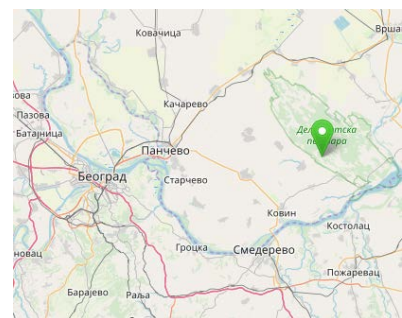
Arrival / Departure times

The camp building is located in Delibalt sands, around 60km east from Belgrade (capital city of Serbia). The building is in the middle of the forest, with sports field in front of it, including enough space for antennas. Inside main building there are big room for lectures and workshops and a room for the radio shack. Inside secondary building there are sleeping rooms and showers/toilets.
